Lesson Policies

Since music lessons are offered during the school day at WIS, it is critical that students are consistently prepared for lessons so that our work together may be productive and worthwhile.

Calendar: Lessons will begin the second week of school and continue following the school calendar to Memorial Day.

Practice: A daily practice and listening routine is essential to good musical progress. Students are required to practice a minimum of 4 days per week.

Preparedness: Students are required to bring all instruments, music books, and other materials to school on the lesson day and return them home after the lesson.

Academic Eligibility: Students must maintain satisfactory progress in their academic work to be eligible to participate in private lessons. Any classroom work missed due to lessons is expected to be completed at home.

Attendance: Due to our complex schedule, lessons missed by a student for illness, field trips, snow days, or any reason, will not be made up. Tuition is calculated assuming two missed lessons by the instructor.

Attitude: Music lessons require a degree of concentration and self-discipline. Any behavior disruptions will be addressed according to WIS policies.

Ensemble: Violin, viola, cello, and bass students are required to participate in the string orchestra ensemble.

Commitment: Learning an instrument is a long-term process. Enrollment requires a non-refundable 1-year commitment.

Students who fail to adhere to Lesson Policies may be dismissed from the program.
