



**Dress Code**  
for  
**Kindergarten to Grade 8 Students**

With our dress code, we wish to build a community spirit among our students about their being a Wisconsin International School student. Pride in their school strengthens their self-confidence and self-worth. Moreover, we wish to keep the focus on learning, bypassing distractions that come from varied clothing styles.

Also to this end, WIS will be selling a **logo T-shirt** in the fall that will become the item of clothing for field trips, special events at or away from school, and other occasion in which our students may be representing WIS in public.

The expectations for the dress code pertain to students in **kindergarten to grade 8**. Lands' End is the official supplier of WIS school clothing and sells school clothing year round. We receive a 3% rebate on all purchases from the school uniform department (phone or internet). Steps for ordering from Lands' End are described below.

Locally, we are aware of these stores offering a selection of school uniform items during the late summer back-to-school season: Target, Sears, Kohl's, and J.C. Penney.

### **Additional guidelines to the dress code:**

- Clothing must be clean and free from rips, tears, holes, and frays.
- All pants, shorts, skirts, and skorts will be worn at the waist. Undergarments should not be showing.
- Shirts must be tucked in.
- Length of shorts, skirts, skorts and jumpers must be appropriate for school.
- Socks must be worn at all times.
- Labeling clothing and shoes helps particularly with students in grades 3 and below.

- Religious head wear is acceptable.
- Hats and non-religious head wear may not be worn inside.
- Hair must be a color that occurs naturally in people.
- A minimum of make-up may be worn by 8<sup>th</sup> graders
- Tattoos are not permitted.
- For safety reasons, hoop and dangling earrings are not appropriate for school.
- Only ear- and nose-bead piercing are acceptable, not other parts of the face or body.

#### For Internet Orders:

At the Lands' End home page [www.landsend.com](http://www.landsend.com), scroll down to the bottom of the page. Under "Specialty Shops" select "School Uniforms." Next select "Find your school's dress code." In the window that opens, select the tab "Preferred School Number." This will bring up a list of items that are eligible for the rebate program. If an item is not on this list but in the Uniform Catalog or uniform website area – it will still be eligible for a 3% rebate as long as the WIS Preferred School Number is used.

#### School Logo on Wisconsin International School Apparel:

You may choose to include a WIS logo on your school uniform. Currently Lands' End is the only vendor providing this service for WIS. By entering the WIS Preferred School Number listed above when ordering, you will gain access to our school logo. There will be an additional charge per logo item, and logo items can delay shipping for up to 5-7 business days.

Please note: the WIS logo is mandatory on the crew neck sweatshirt.
